**Video Surveillance**

The Board authorizes the use of video cameras on ESD property to ensure the health, welfare and safety of all staff, students and visitors to ESD property, and to safeguard district facilities and equipment. Video cameras may be used in locations as deemed appropriate by the Superintendent or designee.

The ESD shall notify staff and students that video surveillance may occur on ESD property. All facilities will have standard signage stating that video surveillance is in use on-premises, regardless of the factual basis of current use, to ensure that at no time persons are recorded without proper notification.

Students or staff in violation of Board policies, administrative regulations, building rules or law shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action. Third parties whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to appropriate sanctions as determined and imposed by the Superintendent or the Board. Students, staff, or third parties may also be referred to law enforcement officials. Individuals may also be referred to law enforcement officials. Licensed staff will be reported to Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, if required by Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 584-020-0041.

A video recording may become a part of a student's educational record or a staff member's personnel record. The ESD shall comply with all applicable state and deferral laws related to record maintenance and retention.
